GENERAL CONFERENCE -

Plenary Sessions will take place July 29-31 and are open to all conference attendees. Topics and speakers are TBD as per TPC Steering and Program committees, and will be announced over the coming months. Open public breakouts will take place between plenaries, July 30-31. Breakouts are organized like mini-workshops with 1/3 of the time for lightning talks and 2/3 of the time for discussion. Pease see the breakout abstracts and lightning talk line-up from TPC's Barcelona Conference for examples of breakout topics for TPC25.

Other breakout topics might include:

- **GraphRAG for Drug Discovery:** How drug companies are using GraphRAG to accelerate drug discovery by seeding foundation models with ground truth from knowledge graphs.
- The State of Al Reasoning Models in Science: How reasoning models such as Deepseek-R1, OpenAl 03-mini, and Anthropic Claude 3.5 Sonnet have the potential to upend the search for scientific discovery.
- **GenAl Needs New Hardware:** As Al workloads evolve, so do their hardware requirements, and bigger might not be better. How might the future be more distributed?

TPC25 HACKATHONS•

The primary mode of engagement within TPC is participation in working groups: self-organized, community-driven teams that focus on specific technical or domain areas. Many working groups have identified collaborative projects, and pre-conference hackathons provide opportunity to synchronize, plan, and make progress on those projects in person. These sessions are open to currently active working group participants, as well as others by invitation; registration for TPC25 allows registrants to apply for an invite.
